I. General Information

Important notes on the operation of the reading magnifier MANO touch 5. Please read them carefully prior to the operation of the reading magnifier!

Notes on the electromagnetic compatibility (EMC)

This reading system is suited for use in all set-ups including the domicile that are connected directly to a public power supply for buildings with residential purposes.

This reading system is designed for the use in the indicated electromagnetic environment. The user should ensure the use in the indicated environment.

This reading system operates on HF-Energy exclusively for its own function. Therefore the emitted interference of high frequency disturbances is very low and the interference with other appliances operated close-by is improbable. When operating the reading system simultaneously with other systems, however, the possibility of disturbances of the system or other systems should not be neglected.

For this reason it should be ensured that the system is not placed directly beside or on top of another system. If the set-up of this system in the proximity of medical, measuring devices cannot be avoided, the operator of these devices has to be informed that it is necessary to observe the performance of the system to control the conventional use of the system in the chosen set-up.

Electronic devices are sensitive towards electric discharge and towards high frequency electromagnetic fields.

Cauting:

In order to avoid high frequency disturbances (e.g. microwaves) the operator should respect a minimum distance of one meter/three feet to portable and mobile HF-telecommunication devices.

The device may not be used in the patients environment.

Storage of the user manual

The user manual is an essential part of MANOtouch5. Please keep the manual in a safe place for future reference.

Product description

MANO touch 5 is an electronic magnifier for text and pictures for permanent and private use .

- clear, virtual touch display (approx . 12,5 cm in diagonal)
- easy, intuitive operation via virtual, customizable buttons with optional tactile feed back (sensitively or acoustically)
- high resolution picture quality, contrast enhanced and flicker free
- continuous magnification from approx . 2,8x to 28x, thanks to cutting-edge camera technology
- multifunctional protective cover, which serves as a sturdy handle with two positions as well as a comfortable reading / writing stand
- distance viewing mode, trapezoid balance, time display, HDMI port, auto ON/OFF, auto focus ON/OFF, inductive charger (available as an option) and more
- the low weight and the ergonomically shaped recessed grips ensure easy and safe handling at home or en route

Medical Device

MANO touch 5 is classified as a medical device, class I, according to 93/42/EEC, Annexe IX, standard 12. For the distribution to countries outside the EU the respective country-specific guidelines have to be regarded.

Purpose

This electronic magnifier is a medical device to assist with the magnification of printed text and pictures . Visually impaired people can compensate for their loss of visual acuity by using this device . For private appliance only.

Evolution and lifetime of products

The Medical Device Directive regulates by law that manufacturers of medical devices shall determine a period of safety operation of a product. We fulfill hereby legal requirements and determine - for formal reasons - a period of three years after date of first purchase.

Note:

The mentioned life span does not reflect the complete life span of the product . It is rather an indication on when the product might be obsolete and substitution might be recommended due to new product developments .

Caution when using around medical devices

In case the end user intends to use this device in combination with another medical devices, it is recommended to get in contact with Reinecker Vision GmbH or with a licensed distributor.

Precautions by alteration of the performance of the device

Should any of the technical features or performances change, the device must be turned OFF and the battery must be taken out . **Please do not switch on the device again.** Refer directly to your authorized dealer or to Reinecker Vision GmbH Service Center .

Reinstatement, installation and maintenance

This device may be technically maintained and reconditioned by Reinecker Vision GmbH only or by an authorized technician . Reinstatement may only take place after the system has been cleaned, disinfected and safety checked .

Cleaning of the system

- MANOtouch 5 has to be disconnected from the power supply before cleaning.
- For cleaning please use the enclosed screen cleaning cloth or any other lint-free, lightly moistened cloth .
- Interior of device must NOT come in contact with liquids .

Special advice for transport and storage

For safety reasons, the unit must only be transported and stored in the original packing. The unit must be stored in dry and closed rooms in the original packing.

The following conditions for transport and storage have to be respected:

- Air pressure: 700 to 1000 hPa
- Temperature range: +5°C to +40°C
- Relative air humidity: 30% to 80%

Disposal of the unit according to EU directive 2002/96/EEC

MANO touch 5 contains of electronic components . To avoid damage to the environment, the country-specific rules have to be respected.





Caution:

The use of any other equipment might lead to an increased electromagnetic emission and to a product damage.

Safety instructions

Please respect the following safety instructions:

- 1. Do not plug the AC adapter into a faulty electrical outlet. Doing so may cause electrical shock or fire.
- 2. Do not touch the AC adapter with wet hands.
- 3. Only use the original battery which is included in the delivery by Reinecker Vision GmbH. The use of any other equipment might lead to a product damage.
- 4. Do not expose MANO touch 5 to direct sunlight or to very hot or cold environment, as this would harm the picture quality .
- 5. Do not use this device below +5°C or above +40°C.
- 6. Keep liquids away from the system . Only operate the device in a dry environment .
- 7. The device may not be used next to medical devices (patients environment), if the device is connected with the power supply.
- 8. Do not try to repair or to dismantle the device by your own. This would automatically void the warranty. If you need any technical assistance please get in contact with the local distributor or with Reinecker Vision GmbH.
- 9. Always turn OFF the system and disconnect it from the power supply before cleaning it. Only use a soft and slightly damped cloth. Only use a mild household detergent. Do not use alcohol containing or strong detergents.

- HD-magnifier MANO touch 5 (without handle)
- HD-magnifier MANO touch 5+ (with handle), incl. 3-button adapter and induction charging station
- Power supply (5V DC/2,4A) incl. connection cable
- 4 removable country adapters (EU, USA, UK, AUS)
- Carrying case with microfibre cloth, incl . hand strap
- User manual

Characteristics

Protective cover

The multifunctional protective cover is firmly connected to the device and protects the display when it is closed .

The device will be turned ON and OFF with the yellow slider .


If you close the protective cover during use, the device switches to standby mode. When the protective cover is opened again, the device switches back to normal operation.



Opening the Protective cover

The protective cover can be folded in a few steps to a handle or to a stable, comfortable reading and writing tripod.

Using the protective cover as reading and writing stand:

Description of the controls

ON/OFF slider

Move the yellow slider to the right in order to turn the unit ON. When the device is in start mode, you will feel two consecutive vibration signals after a few seconds. After about 20 seconds, the camera is activated.

If you move the yellow slider to the right again, the device switches to standby mode . If the slider is pressed for more than 2 seconds, the device will switch OFF.



Touch display

All functions of the device can be activated in an easy and intuitive manner just by tapping the display. All settings can be made via the screen / touch display.

Depending on the needs of the user, the user interface offers extensive configuration options to meet your individual needs.

Each touch of the screen / touch display generates a vibration, optionally the vibration mode can be switched ON or OFF.

Connections

USB type-C for data exchange and power supply

This connection is for the use of power supply and charging with the newest USB technology. You can use this connection also for importing updates or exchanging data e.g. with your computer.

Underneath of this connection you may feel a tactile point which shall give you the direction where to connect your plug. You can plug in your USB cable in any direction.

HDMI connection

With the HDMI output you can connect your TV, external monitor or other devices with a HDMI connection with MANOtouch5. The camera picture will be displayed on the external device in high resolution picture quality.

Audio connection

Reserved for future operations . Connection for outputting audio signals produced by the device.

USB port type-A for extentions

This port is also reserved for upcoming features . It could for example be used for further communication options .

Touch screen functions

When the device is switched ON the screen displays a magnified image in the selected color mode .

Depending on the configuration settings some control elements can be displayed or not (automatically or manually). You can also choose to display or hide them permanently.

Touch display with 3 functional areas

Area 2

Tap this area in order to activate the manual auto focus .

Area 1 and 3

Tap these areas in order to show/hide virtual operation buttons.

Area 4

Not yet in use.



Using the interface

Note: Alternatively you can replace the "+" / "-" symbols by a zoom bar (see chapter "lcon arrangement").





Zoom adjustment at the status bar

To change the zoom factor, touch and hold the zoom controller on the status bar. While keeping the controller pressed, move it to the zoom factor you wish to use.



Zoom in and Zoom out

Tap on the Plus or Minus icon and choose the requested zoom factor.



Color selection and menu selection

Briefly tap this icon in order to scroll within the (up to 14) colors.

Tap and hold this icon in order to activate the menu selection .

Camera icon



Briefly tap the camera icon in order to capture your current picture and to store it.

Tap an hold the camera icon in order to show all stored images.

Note: The photo function is only available, if there is connection from type-C-port (data transfer and power supply) to power supply or computer.

Description of the menu functions


By using the menu it is simple to make the required settings for the user interface.

Battery use

Note: Best conditions for a long life span of your battery is to follow the guidelines below:

- 1. Make sure that the battery has been fully charged prior to first use or if the device haven't been in use for a longer period.
- 2. Connect the enclosed power supply with your wall socket and the USB type C input of the device . During charging, the battery indicator shows a red signal . When fully charged, the battery indicator shows a green signal .
- 3. When the battery status indicator on the screen shows no bar, means, that the battery level is low and the battery shall be charged.
- 4. Charging time of the battery takes approx . 4 hours . When fully charged, operating time is approx . 2 2,5 hours, depending on the brightness adjusted .

Note: If the battery status is low, the unit turns off automatically. If this happens, just connect your unit with a power supply, as described above.

Replacement of batteries

Open the housing carefully at the rear side of the unit before inserting or replacing a battery. Make sure that the contacts of the battery correspond to the contacts of the unit. Then close the cover again.

MANO touch 5 is now ready for operation.



Disposal of batteries

Batteries must be disposed according to the country specific rules . They shall never be burned . Let neither your children nor your pets play with batteries .

Protective circuit of the battery

Despite the protection installed in the battery, it is forbidden to short circuit the contacts of the battery with a metal object. In this case there is a risk of explosion of the battery. This also represents a danger to humans.

Trouble shooting

Problem	Solution
MANO touch 5 doesn't turn ON .	 Make sure, the battery has been charged completely. Charge the battery for approx. 4 hours.
MANO touch 5 has been turned ON but does not show a picture.	• It is possible that the multifunction protective cover is not opened properly and is obscuring the camera.
Auto focus does not react .	 Possibly the manual focus is set . In this mode MANO touch 5 only focuses, if the focus button is pressed . To avoid this you can change from manual focus to auto focus mode in the menu setting . Make sure that no dust comes into contact with the camera lens . Clean the lens with the cleaning cloth provided .
Display is too dark or too bright.	 If no image can be seen on the screen, try adjusting brightness or contrast.
Derating of the battery .	• By repeated charging and discharging the capacity of the battery can be reduced. This may lead to a shorter life span or a reduced performance of the battery.
