# I. General information

Important notes on the operation of the reading system mezzo 2K! Please read them carefully prior to the operation of the reading system!

# Notes on the electromagnetic compatibility (EMC)

This reading system is suited for use in all set-ups including the domicile that are connected directly to a public power supply for buildings with residential purposes. This reading system is designed for the use in the indicated electromagnetic environment. The user should ensure the use in the indicated environment.

This reading system operates on HF-Energy exclusively for its own function. Therefore the emitted interference of high frequency disturbances is very low and the interference with other appliances operated close-by is improbable. When operating the reading system simultaneously with other systems, however, the possibility of disturbances of the system or other systems should not be neglected.

For this reason it should be ensured that the system is not placed directly beside or on top of another system. If the set-up of this system in the proximity of medical, measuring devices cannot be avoided, the operator of these devices has to be informed that it is necessary to observe the performance of the system to control the conventional use of the system in the chosen set-up.

Electronic devices are sensitive towards electric discharge and towards high frequency electromagnetic fields.

#### Attention:

In order to avoid high frequency disturbances the operator should respect a minimum distance of one meter to portable and mobile HF-telecommunication devices. Please also see chapter: Safety advice.

# Storage of the user manual

The user manual is an essential part of your reading system. Please keep the booklet in a safe place for future reference.

# **Product description**

mezzo 2K is a compact desktop video magnifier system, which magnifies text and pictures. It may be used permanently for private and professional appliance. The text or pictures are being captured by the integrated camera and then displayed on the monitor.

- mezzo 2K convinces through razor-sharp picture quality in high resolution and through its user friendliness.
- The 2K camera magnifies text and pictures in the best picture quality, a minimum of picture noise and a high reduction of reflections when reading glossy papers or looking at glossy surfaces.
- The high resolution LED flat srceen is available in different monitor sizes. They are mostly infinitely variable and can be adjusted ergonomically, thanks to their spring compensation.
- Due to its compact design and folding mechanism, mezzo 2K can be easily installed and transported.

- mezzo 2K can be used in both battery and mains operation.
- In combination with one of the optionally available XY-tables the user may increase the comfort of the use.

# **Medical device**

This reading system is classified as a medical device, class I according to (EU) 2017/745, Annexe VIII, standard 13. For the distribution to countries outside the EU the respective country-specific guidelines have to be regarded.

# Purpose

This opto-electronic reading system is a medical device to assist with the reading and magnifying of printed text and pictures. Visually impaired people can compensate for their loss of visual acuity by using this device.

# **Evolution and lifetime of products**

The Medical Device Directive regulates by law that manufacturers of medical devices shall determine a period of safety operation of a product. We fulfill hereby legal requirements and determine - for formal reasons - a period of three years after date of first purchase.

#### Note:

The mentioned life span does not reflect the complete life span of the mezzo 2K. It is rather an indication on when the product might be obsolete and substitution might be recommended due to new product developments.

# Safety advice

mezzo 2K has to be installed in closed and dry rooms only. Do not plug mezzo 2K into an electrical circuit that is also being used for any life sustaining or support systems.

The device may not be used in the patients environment.

This device should not be operated in explosion-endangered environments. This opto-electronic device should only be installed in conjunction with modern electrical circuitry.

# **Combination with other medical products**

**Warning:** This reading system must not be located directly besides, next or on top of another medical life sustaining device. If the device is used near another electrical device, monitor the other device to ensure that it is working properly. In case of doubt please contact Reinecker Vision GmbH or any licensed distribution partner.

# Precautions by alteration of the performance of the system

Stop using the reading device if technical features or performances should change. Switch the device OFF and disconnect the power supply from the mains wall socket. Refer directly to your authorized dealer or to Reinecker Vision GmbH Service Center. Do not use the system again in this condition.

# **Reinstatement/installation and maintenance**

This device may be technically maintained and reconditioned by Reinecker Vision GmbH only or by an authorized technician. Reinstatement may only take place after the system has been cleaned and safety checked.

# **Cleaning of the system**

- mezzo 2K has to be disconnected from the power supply before cleaning.
- Clean the system with a slightly damp cloth and a mild household detergent.
- Interior of device must NOT come in contact with liquids.

# Special advice for transport and storage

For reasons of safety, the unit must only be transported and stored in the original packing. The unit must be stored in dry and closed rooms in the original packing. The following conditions for transport and storage have to be respected:

Air pressure 700 - 1000 hPa

- Temperature range +5°C to + 50°C
- Relative air humidity 30% to 80%

# Disposal of the unit according to (EU) 2012/19

mezzo 2K contains of electronic components. To avoid damage to the environment, the country-specific rules have to be respected.



# **Power supply**

Only use the original power supply and cables which are included in the delivery by Reinecker Vision GmbH.

**Caution:** The use of any other equipment might lead to an increased electromagnetic emission and to a product damage.

# **Safety of batteries**

For safety reasons, the manufacturer recommends replacing the battery after two years. If the battery has not been changed after this period of time, the manufacturer accepts no responsibility and excludes any recourse.

**Note:** Replacing of the batteries can only be done by Reinecker Vision or an authorized technician.

# Safety instructions to avoid damage

Please respect the following instructions for your own safety:

- 1. Do not plug the AC adapter into a faulty electrical outlet. Doing so may cause electrical shock or fire.
- 2. Do not touch the AC adapter with wet hands.
- 3. Only use the original power supply and cables which are included in the delivery by Reinecker Vision GmbH. The use of any other equipment might lead to a product damage.
- 4. For products with battery operation only: Only use the original battery, which is included in the delivery by Reinecker Vision GmbH. The use of any other equipment might lead to a product damage.
- 5. Do not expose the system to direct sunlight or to very hot or cold environment, as this would harm the picture quality.
- 6. Do not operate this device below +5°C or above +40°C.
- 7. No liquids must reach the interior of the system. Only operate the device in a dry environment.
- 8. The device may not be operated next to medical devices (patients environment).
- 9. Do not lean on the screen, touch the screen with any object or lay heavy objects on the device. This may cause damage to the device.
- 10. Do not try to repair or to dismantle the system by your own. This would automatically void the warranty. If you need any technical assistance please get in contact with the local distributor or with Reinecker Vision GmbH.
- 11. Always switch OFF the system and disconnect it from the power supply before cleaning it. Only use a soft and slightly damped cloth. Only use a mild household detergent. Do not use alcohol containing or strong detergents.

# The mezzo 2K camera

#### 2K camera with optical zoom/auto-focus

- Magnification from approx. 1,9 x to 53x
- Icomology: high quality pictures with virtually no picture noise
- Technology: reduces shadows while hand writing and reflections while reading from shiny surfaces

# **Connection of the unit**

Connect the power supply to a mains wall socket and plug the adapter end of the cable into the AC input socket (12V DC) located on the base plate of the mezzo 2K.

#### Note:

The supplied plug-in power supply is exclusively for the operation of this device. Please do not use any other power adaptor or cable. Once the device is plugged in, it is ready to use.



# Installation of the system

Unpack your mezzo 2K carefully and place it on a solid horizontal surface. If you have not purchased an optionally available stand that fits to the product you must provide a solid surface for the system with sufficient surface area.

Set up your mezzo 2K as described below:



• Raise the camera tripod until the arm copletely locks into place.



# **Alignment of monitor**

Due to the monitor's technology contrast and brightness adjust depending on the angle of view.

The highly flexible monitor arm enables you to adjust the monitors height and angle according to your best ergonomic position.



• The monitor can be moved vertically up and down.

# Switching between reading mode and distance viewing mode

#### Position in reading mode

This camera position is suitable for reading text, looking at objects or writing.

# Position in distance viewing mode

Swivel the camera horizontally to 90°.



#### Alignment of the XY-table mezzo 2K

If your mezzo 2K is optionally equipped with an XY-table (ZBXTFIX0 or ZBXTFIXM) with friction brakes, the friction can be continuously adjusted with the lever located in front of the table by pushing the lever slowly from the left to the right.

By pushing the lever from the very left side (no friction at all) to the center, you will fix the y-axis. By pushing the lever to the very right side, you will also fix the x-axis (lock).

- 1. Left: no friction at all
- 2. Left to center: fixing the y-axis
- **3.** Center to right: fixing the x- and y-axis (lock)



# Controls at the rear of the camera

# Autofocus ON/OFF

By using the autofocus key, autofocus can be turned ON or OFF. The status of the autofocus function is displayed for approximately 4 seconds at the bottom of the screen. When the autofocus is switched ON, the camera will automatically adjust the focus setting.



# **Mirror image**

The picture display on the monitor can be changed to operate as if you were looking at a mirror. This is useful if you want to perform a personal task such as shaving or applying make up. To enter into mirror mode, press and hold down the zoom + and zoom – keys, until the display briefly indicates "mirror ON". Then, flip the camera up as if you were using the distance mode. Rotate the camera as far as you can back towards you. It cannot rotate back the full circle, so you will have to re-position the base of the unit to get the camera pointing towards the user. For best operation, turn the Autofocus OFF while in mirror mode.

# Zoom + / -

The magnification can be increased or decreased by using the keys +/-.

# **Overview mode**

If you are working with a higher magnification and you do not know which area of the reading material or which part of the room you want to locate, this function will give you an overview of the magnified area.

To activate the overview mode and temporarily zoom out for scanning (either in reading or distance mode), hold down the AF key until "overview mode" is displayed at the bottom left of the screen and the camera zooms out.

The cross-hair in the middle of the picture serves as a locator for the material you want to magnify. Center the cross hair on the desired viewing object and then release the AF key. The camera will then automatically zoom back in and return to your original magnification setting.

# Control panel on base plate – for mezzo 2K with battery operation



# Power switch ON/OFF



The device can be switched ON or OFF by briefly pressing the yellow button. When the device is switched ON the green LED lights on.

When the device will be turned OFF, the latest used settings are saved automatically. When switching ON again, the latest used settings are reactivated.

#### Attention!:

If the reading table is not lit up after switching ON the device, please check if the LED-light is ON (please see next paragraph).

# Light adjustment (ON/OFF/Dim)



By pressing the black button briefly the illumination can be turned ON or OFF.

By pressing and holding the black button, the illumination can be dimmed. When releasing the black button, the illumination intensity will be set and saved.

#### Please note:

The latest used illumination will be reactivated when turning the device ON the next time.

# Indicator for rechargeable battery



Indicates the status of the built-in battery. Note: When the battery is nearly empty, the device switches OFF automatically.

In this case, connect the device to the power supply and recharge the battery. During charging, the yellow battery indicator on the device lights up.

# **Monitor control panel**



# Left button:

#### **Colour mode selection**

This button can be turned endlessly to the right or to the left and will always change the positions of the color mode (1-6):

	Position 1:	full colour display
	Position 2:	black font, white background
J	Position 3:	white font, black background
	Position 4:	green font, black background
	Position 5:	yellow font, black background
	Position 6:	vellow font, blue background

The chosen colour mode appears temporarily on the lower side of the screen (when activated).

**Note:** Individual colour combinations can be defined via the internal menu. You also have the possibility to reduce the colour combinations. If you, for example, reduce the 6 combinations to four, these four combinations are evenly divided on the positions of the button.

#### **Menu selection ON/OFF**

Press and hold the color selection button for approx. 2 seconds to display or exit the internal menu.

# **Central button:**

#### Zoom +/-

By turning the central button endlessly (from left to right) text and pictures can be zoomed in and out continuously.



The magnification range from approx. 1,9x - 53x, depends on the distance between the camera and the object to be displayed.

The last magnification adjustment will be saved and displayed when turning the mezzo 2K ON again.

The current magnification will be displayed briefly at the bottom of the screen (this display can be deactivated in the user menu).

**Note:** The camera is equipped with an auto-focus. When turning the central button to the maximum magnification, objects of a height of (>) 8cm shall be displayed sharply.

# Auto-focus ON/OFF

By briefly pressing and releasing the central ("zoom") button the auto-focus can be activated/deactivated. By having the auto-focus activated, the camera adjusts the picture sharpness automatically.

#### **Overview mode**

When you are reading at a higher magnification level and want to find out which part of the page you have reached, this function helps you to get the overview.

Press the central ("zoom") button at a higher magnification level for approximately 2 seconds until the overview mode is activated. The image on the screen will minimise and you will see an overview of the whole document/image/printed text. A faded cross will appear and indicate the area that is currently being magnified. Once the central button is released it will return back to the reading mode and selected magnification level.

# **Right button:**

#### Automatic colour saturation

Brightness and colour saturation are automatically adjusted, colours are displayed true to original. The colour saturation range can also be adjusted in the menu.

#### **Brightness/Contrast**



The right button can be turned endlessly to the right and to the left to adjust brightness and contrast.

That means that both, bright and dark image zones change equally. turn to the left: lowest contrast, lowest brightness

turn to the right: maximum contrast, maximum brightness

#### Line marker and shadowing



By pressing and turning the right button, line marker and shadowing will be activated. The line ruler can be moved up and down by endlessly turning the rotary knob.

By repeated pressing of the operating key, the line cover will be activated/deactivated. The line coverage can be evenly divided up/ down over the entire screen using the endless rotary knob.

**Note:** the horizontal line cover corresponds to the factory setting. It can be set individually via the menu.

To deactivate those functions, press the button again.

# **Power ON/OFF**

#### **Operation with power supply and cables**

Make sure that the delivered power adapter and cable are connected properly with a wall socket and mezzo 2K AC input 12V DC.

#### **Power ON**

Press the ON/OFF button to switch ON the device. When the mezzo 2K and the base plate is illuminated, you can put a page or an object onto the table. All the possible settings – for example zoom, colour or brightness- can be adjusted individually.

# **Power OFF**

Switch OFF the device by pressing the ON/OFF button.

# Automatic saving of device settings

All last used device settings are automatically saved after approx. 5 sec. and are active when the device is switched on again.

# **Replacement of lighting**

The electronic magnifier is equipped with a high power LED Illumination. If replacement of the lamp is required it should only be done by a specialist or by Reinecker Vision GmbH.

# Important note to the use of power supply

Please only use the power supply included in the delivery. Use of any other power supply will void the warranty!

# **Operation of rechargeable battery**

(mezzo 2K with battery operation only)

**Attention:** In order to assure a long life span of the rechargeable battery you must follow the instructions for charging and operating the battery:

- The yellow battery indicator LED on the device does not expire until the charging process has finished.
- If the device is not used for a longer period (more than 1 month), the battery must be fully charged. Even if the device is switched OFF, the battery can discharge until deep discharge. This should be avoided, as the rechargeable battery can be damaged.

# Use of battery

- Plug-in power supply is not connected.
- Keep pressing the ON/OFF button for approx. 1 second; device is ready to be used.
- Directly after switching ON, the battery charging status appears briefly on the screen.
- As soon as the battery charging status on the screen starts blinking, the battery must be charged immediately. Only a few minutes remain before the unit switches OFF automatically.
- If the device continues to run on battery mode, the battery must first be fully charged.

# **Charging of battery**

- The battery charge indicator is blinking or the device has switched OFF.
- Please connect plug-in-power supply.
- The yellow battery control LED at the unit lights up the battery is charging.
- When the battery is fully charged, the battery control LED will turn OFF.
- The device is ready again for battery operation.
- While charging the battery, the device can be used without restriction. In this way, the battery can be charged during operation.

# Operating time once the battery had been fully charged

- With 16" class monitor: approx. 4,5 hours (depending on the illumination used)
- Charging time is approx. 5,0 hours, when the unit is turned OFF.

Press and hold the color selection button for approx. 2 seconds until the internal menu disappears from the screen.



#### Move up/down the menu

Turn the central zoom button in order to navigate through the menu.

**Select an item in the menu** Press the central zoom button in order to open the menu selection.

#### Change menu selection

Turn the central zoom button in order to change menu settings.

#### Confirm and select the menu selection

Press the central zoom button in order to confirm menu settings.
