
# BrailleTeach - User Guide




Games are played using the front face, which features the six dots that represent the Braille 6-dot code.

Starting position: All dots must be pressed down - the surface must be flat
Letter/number position: Raise dots by pressing them according to the Braille 6-dot code

The dots are allocated with the numbers 1-6 in the formation known as the Braille Cell:

#### The Braille Cell



For example, to create the letter b, the dots 1 and 2 must be raised up and dots 3,4,5 and 6 must be flat.



#### The 4 side buttons (2 on left, 2 on right) are used for menu and game controls.

Top left
Confirm/OK
Single click to confirm an action, and enter a menu

Top right
(Games) Cancel/Skip
Single click to skip an action, double click to exit game/settings

Bottom left
(Menu) Previous Item

Bottom right
(Menu) Next Item
Click to navigate between menu items

### Menu Structure

  - 1. I will read the letter the device will tell you which letter you have created when you raise the dots
  - 2. Guess the letter the device will announce a letter and you must enter the right combination of raised dots; if you make an error, the device will prompt you to try again. If you raise the combination of dots correctly, you will automatically move to the next random letter
  - 3. Learn how letters are written the device will announce a letter and teach you the correct 6-dot combination
  - 4. Guess the letters within the time limit the device will announce letters and you must enter the correct 6-dot combinations within one minute

- Number Games the device contains 4 games to teach the numbers & symbols
  - 1. I will read the number and symbols the device will tell you which number/symbol you have created when you raise the dots
  - 2. Guess the number the device will announce a number/symbol and you must enter the right combination of raised dots; if you make an error, the device will prompt you to try again. If you raise the combination of dots correctly, you will automatically move to the next random number/symbol
  - 3. Learn how numbers and symbols are written the device will announce a number/symbol and teach you the correct 6-dot combination
  - 4. Guess the numbers within the time limit the device will announce numbers/symbols and you must enter the correct 6-dot combination within one minute

## How to recharge

The devices works with a built-in LiPo rechargeable battery. You must charge the device using the USB cable included to the box. Keep the charging cable connected for full charge until the red light will turn off. Full charge takes approximately 60 minutes
